### Auxiliary Scholarship requirements

The Howard County Medical Center Auxiliary of St. Paul, Nebraska has established two scholarships of \$2000 each for students entering an approved medical or health related course of study following high school graduation. A check will be given towards tuition at the beginning of the second semester made payable to the school of their choice. **If the recipient is NOT enrolled in a health related field of study at this time, the scholarship will go to the alternate.**

Students may apply who meet the following criteria:

- \*Senior who is a resident of Howard County
- \*Planning a career in medical or health related field
- \*Student in good standing in his/her graduating class

A student may apply for this scholarship in the following manner:

1. Letter of application to the Auxiliary telling about yourself and your goals
2. Transcript of grades signed by school official
3. List of your community service activities
4. Reason why you want to go into the medical field, who influenced your decision
5. Letters of reference; 1 from school and at least 2 from adults outside the school

Applications must be received by the Howard County Medical Center Auxiliary by

**APRIL 1, 2021**

All applications will be reviewed by a committee, who will select the winners and an alternate who will become the recipient in the event the winner cannot use the scholarship.
